

Extra INT call for semester 2014A

Deadline – 27 January 2014, 11.59 CET

After reviewing the proposals for the Isaac Newton Telescope (INT) it turned out that several nights are still available for Dutch astronomers. The time allocation committee has decided to offer a second chance for the Dutch astronomers to apply for these nights.

To be more precise, nights are available:

with the IDS/Red+2 instrument on:

12, 13, 14 Feb
21, 22 May
20, 21 Jul

with the WFC instrument

10, 11, 12 Mar
19, 20, 21 Mar
9, 10, 11 Apr
11, 12 May
8 Jun
29 Jul
31 Jul

Note that there are no unallocated nights available for the WHT.

If you are interested to use those nights, please send a short proposal to the chair of the Dutch time allocation committee for the island observatories Jarle Brinchmann (jarle@strw.leidenuniv.nl) with cc to eilandstrw@nwo.nl, latest at noon Monday the 27-th of January. There is no fixed format for the proposal but the scientific and technical justification should not exceed 1 page A4 at 11 pt and you can have one further page for figures. Please make sure to include your contact information and affiliation.

There exists also a limited possibility to ask for the observations to be carried out by student observers at the ING. In this case the observers should be added as co-authors of any paper coming out of the observations and also note that this requires at least one month advance warning. If you wish to take advantage of this possibility, please indicate so at the bottom of the technical justification.

If the proposal is successful, you might be required to supply more information for administrative and technical reasons.
