



M51 Galaxy or the Whirlpool Galaxy. This is a bright spiral galaxy fairly close to us. To the north of M51, at the top of the image, is a companion galaxy which is being disrupted by the gravitational tidal forces of the main galaxy. The image was obtained using the Prime Focus Camera of the William Herschel Telescope, and in particular the B-band image was acquired by SAR el Príncipe de Asturias (Crown Prince of Spain).
